Day 3 Bible Story Script: Come Sit at the Table

Text: Based on Luke 14:15–24

Big Idea: *God wants everyone to be part of His family.*

Waypoint: *Belonging – Make Room for Someone New*

Key Phrase (repeat often): “There’s room at the table!”

1. Let’s Talk About Tables and Belonging

Storyteller (stand beside 2–3 kid-sized chairs and a small table):

Have you ever walked into lunch at school and not known where to sit?
That feels **lonely**, doesn’t it?

But how does it feel when someone says, “You can sit with me!”
(*Have kids repeat it.*)

That feels **warm and kind**, like you belong.

Today, Jesus tells a story about a big dinner—a banquet—and how God wants **everyone** to be invited!

2. The Big Party Is Ready

Jesus said there once was a man who planned a **big party**. Let’s all say,

“Big party!”

He had yummy food. He set out plates. He had a beautiful table.
He said, “Go tell everyone - it’s dinner time!”

But the people who were invited started making **excuses**.

Let’s all shake our heads and say,
“No thank you.”
(*Kids repeat*)

One person said, “I just bought a field.”
Another said, “I’m busy with animals.”
Another said, “I just got married!”

Nobody wanted to come.

3. Empty Chairs

(Point to the empty chairs by the table.)
The table was ready, but the seats were empty.



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Can you all say, "That's so sad!"
(Kids repeat)

But the man didn't give up.

He said to his servant, "Go find more people!"

Go find people in the streets! People who don't get invited anywhere! People who feel left out!

So the servant ran out and started saying: "You're invited! Come sit at the table!"
(Have kids say it too.)

4. The People Come

People came—lots of people!

They were so happy to be invited.
Some of them had never been to a party before.
Some of them had never been told, "You matter."

So they came and sat down. **(Place toy food or cups at the table. Pretend to welcome guests.)**

And the table started to fill up!

But guess what? "There was still room at the table!"
(Kids repeat)

So the servant went out **again** and invited even more people!
Because the man wanted the house to be **full**.

5. What Jesus Was Teaching Us

Jesus told this story to say:

God loves everyone.
And **God invites everyone.**

Not just the popular kids. Not just the kids who follow all the rules.
Everyone.

And you know what?

We can be just like the servant in the story.



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We can say,
"You can sit with me!"
"You belong here!"

Because there is always room at God's table.

6. Wrap-Up & Response

(Pick up a chair.)

This chair reminds us:

- We don't just sit by ourselves.
- We look around and say, "Who needs a seat?"

So let's say it one more time, loud and clear:
"There's room at the table!"
