Day 1 Crafts: Brilliance Binoculars

Description

Today's craft helps our youngest campers explore the world like little adventurers! They'll make and decorate a pair of pretend binoculars to help them "spot brilliance" all around them—reminding them that God's creation (and they!) are one-of-a-kind.

Supplies

- 2 toilet paper tubes per camper
- Yarn or string (pre-cut to hang around the neck)
- Tape or glue dots
- Hole punch
- Markers, stickers, foam shapes, or dot markers for decorating

Setup

Punch two holes on the outside of each set of glued-together tubes ahead of time if possible. Pre-cut yarn for faster stringing.

How to Make It

- Give each camper two cardboard tubes taped together to form binoculars.
- Let them decorate their binoculars however they like! Encourage sparkle, dots, stripes—whatever shows their style.
- Help them thread yarn through the holes and tie it off so they can wear it around their neck.
- Once complete, invite them to "spot brilliance" around the room or outdoors!
