Day 3 Crafts: Belonging Compass

Description

Campers will create compass necklaces that remind them God always points them in the right direction—and there's always a place for them on His path. It's a wearable reminder of belonging and purpose.

Supplies

- Plastic toy compasses
- Foam shapes or circles
- Pre-cut yarn or lanyard cord
- Hole punch
- Stickers, markers, and glue dots for decorating

Setup

Punch holes in foam shapes ahead of time. Lay out decorations buffet-style for kids to choose from.

How to Make It

- Have campers decorate their foam piece however they want.
- Help them attach the compass to the foam using a glue dot.
- Thread yarn through the foam hole and tie it off as a necklace.
- Let them wear it proudly—and talk about what it means to know where you belong!

Wrap-Up Connection

This compass doesn't just point north—it reminds you that you belong on God's path, no matter where you go.
