### Day 2 Crafts: Bold Birdhouses

#### Description

Today, kids will paint their very own mini birdhouse—a cozy, colorful place that shows how God welcomes everyone. It's a chance to be bold with colors and talk about making room for others to belong.

#### Supplies

- Pre-built wooden birdhouses (one per camper)
- Paint and paintbrushes
- Paper plates or trays for paint
- Smocks or old shirts to protect clothing
- Water cups and paper towels

#### Setup

Cover tables and prep paint trays with a few color options. Smocks on before painting begins!

#### How to Make It

- Give each camper a wooden birdhouse and let them choose their paint colors.
- Encourage them to be bold and creative with their designs—there's no wrong way to paint!
- As houses dry, invite kids to show each other their birdhouses and celebrate one another's work.

#### Wrap-Up Connection

Each birdhouse is different—just like each of you! But every birdhouse is a home, and every person belongs in God's family. Your birdhouse is a symbol of welcome and love.
