Day 3 Bible Story Script: Come Sit at the Table

Text: Based on Luke 14:15–24

Big Idea: *God wants everyone to be part of His family.*

Waypoint: *Belonging – Make Room for Someone New*

Key Verse: Ephesians 2:10

Bible Story Summary

Jesus told a parable about a man who planned a big banquet and invited many people. But when the invited guests made excuses and didn't come, the man sent his servant out to invite others—the poor, the forgotten, and anyone he could find—so that the table would be full. The story shows that God's invitation is for everyone, not just the popular or important. Jesus wants us to make room for others, just like He does.

1. Let's all say it together: "There's room at the table!"

- Who got invited to the big party in Jesus' story?

2. Can you show me your sad face?

- How do you think it felt when people said, "No thank you" to the party?

3. Let's pretend to walk down the street like the servant.

- Who did the servant invite next? (Help them answer: people who were left out or forgotten!)

4. Have you ever been left out or didn't know where to sit?

- How did it feel when someone said, "You can sit with me!"?

5. Let's pretend to pull out a chair and pat the seat.

- Who can you invite to come sit with you this week?
