Bottom Line: Jesus carries our bricks once and for all

Key Text: Hebrews 4:14–16

In Large Group Recap

Tonight we learned that in the Old Testament, God's people needed a High Priest who offered sacrifices again and again for their sins. But Jesus came as the perfect High Priest. He was fully God and fully human, and He never sinned. On the cross, He carried our bricks once and for all, and when He rose again, He proved that we can approach God with confidence. His response to us is always mercy and grace.

Question from Stage:

What makes Jesus different from anyone else who could carry our bricks?

Discussion Guide

1. Warm-Up

- What is one thing from large group tonight that really stood out to you?
- Why do you think the story of Jesus being the “Great High Priest” is such good news?

2. Dig Deeper

- In the past, sacrifices had to be made over and over. Why was that not enough?
- How is Jesus taking our bricks to the cross different from anything else?
- The Bible says Jesus understands our weakness and struggles because He lived as a human. Why is that important to know?

3. Apply It

- Does anyone feel comfortable sharing what was on their label so we can help carry that burden together?
- How can we continue to care for one another? If you could ask this group to do something to help you with your burden, what would that be?
- How would you live differently if you had total confidence that God accepted you?
- If Jesus has already carried our bricks, what should we do when guilt or shame still weighs us down?

4. Close in Prayer

Thank Jesus for being the Great High Priest who carried our bricks once and for all. Pray for group members by name, asking God to help them trust His mercy and grace, and to feel cared for by their community.
