### In Large Group Recap

### Discussion Guide

#### 1. Warm-Up

- What is one memory from this weekend that you'll never forget?
- What do you think made being in your group this weekend so meaningful?

#### 2. Dig Deeper

- Why do you think Paul told Christians to carry each other's burdens?
- What does it feel like when someone cares for you or helps you through something heavy?
- How is being part of God's family (the church) different from just trying to figure out life alone?

#### 3. Apply It

- What are some real, everyday ways we can carry each other's burdens at school, on a team, or at church?
- If you were to describe this weekend to a friend who wasn't here, what would you want them to know most?
- Who is one person you know that might need to hear that they don't have to carry their bricks alone?
- How could our small group continue to support each other after this weekend?

#### 4. Close in Prayer

Take time to thank God for the gift of community. Pray that He would help each preteen remember that they are not alone and give them courage to share the love of Jesus with others when they return home.
