

Toddlers | W2



Hear it On the Phone

What You Need

 "Hear it On the Phone" Activity Page	0

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Copy "Hear it On the Phone" on cardstock and cut, one cutout per child. Write each child's name on their phone.

During the Activity: Encourage children to decorate their phone.

LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today's true story from the Bible (*hold up the Bible*) is about a man named Philip. (*Hold up the picture of Philip.*) Philip was friends with Jesus, and Philip loved God.

"Philip listened to God and went to find the man in the chariot. (*Hold up the picture of Philip running towards the man in the chariot.*) When Philip found him, the man was reading God's words but needed help understanding them. (*Hold up the picture of Philip standing next to the man in the chariot reading.*) Philip helped him so he could hear from God. We can hear from God too when we read the Bible (*hold up the Bible*) and look at the pictures, or when someone reads the Bible to us! The Bible has God's words in it, and it teaches us how to do what God says and love like Jesus. **[Bottom Line] The Bible teaches you the best things.**"

What You Say:

During the Activity: "The Bible teaches us the BEST things like God made me. God loves me. And Jesus wants to be my friend forever. That's what the words on your phone say. Decorate your phone with the markers and stamps. (*Pause.*) Great job! [Child's name], hold the phone up to your ear and listen. **[Bottom Line] The Bible teaches you the best things.**"
