*Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!*

**LEADER:** "Hello, friends! I'm so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today's true story from the Bible (*hold up the Bible*) begins when Jesus and His friends, the disciples, were walking to the city of Jerusalem. But this day, Jesus rode on the little donkey to Jerusalem.

"The people in Jerusalem were so excited that Jesus was coming to their town, so they made a special path on the road with coats and palm branches. When Jesus walked on the path, people waved palm branches in the air and shouted: 'Hosanna! Hosanna! Yay, Jesus!'
